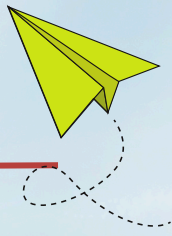

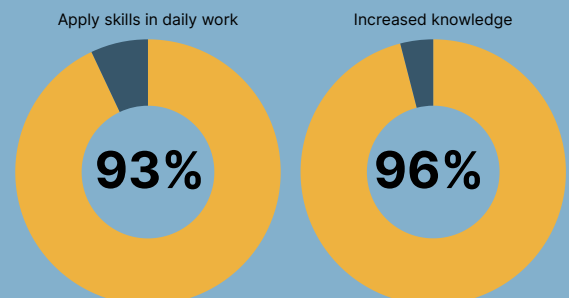
Children in New Hampshire lack access to afterschool programs

The New Hampshire Out-of-School Time (OST) Convention is the only statewide gathering dedicated to supporting the professionals working to close this gap. The event provides space for afterschool and youth development educators to connect, learn, and collaborate, strengthening practice, leadership, and sustainability so more children and families can access high-quality OST opportunities.
























The New Hampshire Out-of-School Time Convention gives providers:

- Networking, professional learning, and capacity-building opportunities alongside **100+** out-of-school time professionals from across New Hampshire each year
- Access to inspiring keynote speakers and a diverse lineup of workshops covering topics such as STEM/STEAM, family engagement, social emotional learning, leadership, workforce development, and program quality
- Connections with local and national exhibitors sharing resources, tools, and services designed to strengthen out-of-school time programs
- The opportunity to earn professional development hours, consistent with the professional learning framework historically offered through ACROSS NH's statewide OST convention

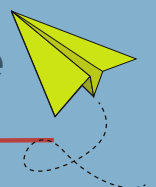
